

Mail-In Sharpening Steps

1

**Tell your wife
you love her, and
you're having her
knives sharpened.**

2

Download and complete the Mail-in Sharpening document. This will include the number of items to be sharpened, as well as any repairs needing to be made.

3

Gather your knives, scissors or other items to be sharpened. You will also need newspaper or butcher paper, masking or blue tape and a shipping box. Your local post office should have 'Medium' Flat Rate Boxes' and shipping labels available.

4

Take 2 full sheets of newspaper and fold in half (like a book).

5



Lay the first knife, approximately 1-2 inches from the bottom of the newspaper. The handle should be placed outwards, with part of the handle on the newspaper.

Fold the bottom of the newspaper over the blade of the knife.

7



**Roll the knife over itself once,
securing it between the
newspaper.**

8



For the next knife, place the back/top of the knife onto newspaper next to the first knife.

9

**Roll the first knife
on top of the
inserted knife.**

**Roll again, so the
knife is secured in
newspaper.**

Continue this process until all knives are securely wrapped in the newspaper. Approximately 5 knives will fit.

11



Place tape at the top near the knife handles, wrapping around twice to secure the handles.

12



Fold the end of the newspaper (near tips of knives) over, then fold in the loose corners creating a triangular shape.

13



Place tape on the folded newspaper, wrapping around twice to secure the tips.

14

Continue this process until all knives are securely wrapped.

15



Crumple about 4 sheets of news paper. Place in the bottom of the box, to add a cushioned barrier.

16

As you pack the box keep in mind, the longest knife package will need to be placed so the tip & handle are lined up with the corner of the box. Start with the shortest/smallest set, place the tips of the wrapped knives into the crumpled paper at the bottom of the box at a slight angle, so the handles are touching the side of the box.

17



Continue placing wrapped knives in, securing the tips in the crumbled paper in the bottom of the box.

18



Once all wrapped knives are in the box, place crumpled paper around the sides of the box, to cushion the knives completely. You should not be able to hear the knives when you shake the box.
